## Stack and stage all cut materials along edge of roadway

- ✓ Stack all fresh cuts facing the street. Arrange piles in a row.
- ✓ Cut materials shall be from your legal parcel.
- ✓ Arrange piles neatly. Failure to do may result in rescheduled chipping.
- ✓ **NO** Stumps or any other root materials.
- ✓ **NO** limbs larger than 8" in diameter.
- ✓ **NO** mud, rocks, construction materials, trash, thorns, leaf litter, poison oak.
- ✓ **NO Palms or Bamboo**
